

Cremation Guide

The four cremation plans, what each one costs, and what is included in the price.

Four plans

Every one of them includes our professional services, bringing your loved one into our care, and the cremation itself. **The only thing that changes between them is how much ceremony you want.** Direct cremation starts at **\$3,055**; a full viewing and funeral before the cremation is **\$6,725**.

THE FOUR PLANS

To be eligible, the cremation container must be purchased from Bonney Watson. Sales tax is added to merchandise; Friday/Saturday/Sunday, holiday, and evening ceremonies may carry additional fees.

PRICING

The prices here vary a good deal by size, location and the options you choose, so a single figure would be misleading. Call or email me and I will put an exact quote in writing for you, with no obligation.

What witnessing involves. Families who choose to be present see the container placed into the chamber. Once the chamber is closed, you're welcome to press the button to begin the cremation yourself. Tell us ahead of time if you want to witness, so we can schedule it.

DEATH CERTIFICATES

A death certificate is an official legal document you'll need to settle accounts, transfer property, claim benefits, and handle other affairs after a loss.

How the process works. A physician signs and states the cause of death. Our team gathers the required information and files the completed certificate with the county, typically 7–10 business days.

How many do you need. We recommend one certified copy for each of: life insurance, bank accounts, real estate or mortgage, retirement or pension, military benefits, vehicle titles, and utilities or credit cards.

Cost in Washington. Each certified copy is \$25.00. Pierce County adds a \$4.00 shipping fee plus a \$10.00 review fee. If a correction is needed, the WA Department of Health allows one free exchange, but corrected certificates can take up to 8 weeks.

KEY THINGS TO KNOW

- Order more than you think you need. Reordering later takes time.
- We handle the filing on your behalf, so there is no need to visit the health department yourself.
- Ask each institution whether they require a certified copy or accept a photocopy.
