

Garden of Meditation Niches

A stepped black granite wall in a planted garden: sold as companion niches, with two firm rules worth knowing before you choose.

A garden, not a room

The Garden of Meditation niches are one stepped wall of polished black granite set into a planted bed, with bronze plates and bronze vase holders. There is no roof, no courtyard and no room: you stand on the path in front of it with the lawn and the trees behind you. Every niche here is sold as a companion, for two people on one contract.

Rows run A at the bottom to G at the top, and the row is what sets the price: the lower rows are the least expensive, the top of the taller centre section the most.

THE COMPANION NICHE

Sold as Companions

Two people, one niche, one contract, and one urn that fits

Every niche here is sold as a companion, with two rights of interment, and includes one niche vase. Price follows the row: the lower rows are the least expensive and the top of the centre section the most.

NICHE PRICE RANGE

\$5,995–\$8,995

Because of the size of the niche, the Interlude Urn is required, and two of them fit. The companion capacity and the urn requirement are one fact rather than two: the niche holds two people because two Interlude Urns fit in it. The Interlude Urn is **\$665** each plus **10.4% sales tax**. It is merchandise, quoted alongside the niche rather than charged as a fee, and it is worth bringing into the urn conversation early rather than choosing an urn first.

TWO FIRM RULES

Two Rules for This Wall

Both are firm, and both are easier to hear now than later

TWO RULES FOR THIS WALL

“NO PHOTOS ALLOWED” is a firm rule at the Garden of Meditation, reproduced here word for word. It is about what may go on the niche front: the wall carries bronze plates and bronze vase holders and nothing else, so no photograph is added to a plate here. Ask your family service director how it applies to what you have in mind.

“E.C.F: 10% — *E.C.F is not included in listed pricing***”** means the Endowment Care Fund charge is added to the niche price rather than contained in it.

Up to two inscriptions may be added to the front of a companion niche, one for each person.

What It Costs

The niche, the charges alongside it, and the urn

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

Opening and closing, recording, endowment care and any inscription are charged in addition to the price of the space. They are straightforward, and they differ by location and by what you choose. Call or email me and I will put the exact figures in writing for you, with no obligation.

About these charges. They follow the **Mountain View Columbarium, June 2026** schedule, confirmed 2026-07-31. They are not the older amounts printed on this location's own sheet; they replace them, and they are the current ones.

WHAT IS OPEN TODAY

What Is Available Now

A small number, in three rows

18 of the 168 niches on the wall are for sale today, in the \$5,995, \$6,995 and \$8,995 rows. Only part of the wall is offered at any one time, and this is an established garden rather than a brand-new one, so the row and the height still available today may not be there in a month.

BEFORE YOU COME OUT

Decide whether an outdoor garden wall is what you want rather than a courtyard or an indoor room. **Bring the Interlude Urn into the conversation early** — it is required here, and two of them fit. **Then decide the row:** the lower rows are the least expensive and the top of the centre section the most.

Ranges here are computed from the price and availability data behind our live niche maps, so they describe what is offered for sale today and move as spaces sell. I confirm the exact niche, its price and today's availability before anything is signed.

Walk the path with me

The wall is best seen from the path in front of it, and the row you are looking at is the whole price question. Tell me which one and I will confirm what is open on it today, what it costs with the urn and the charges, and put it in writing with no obligation attached.

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
