

Rock of Ages Columbarium

A granite courtyard columbarium at Washington Memorial Park: the two sides of it, what a niche costs, and what is still open.

Granite, two rights

Rock of Ages is a granite columbarium built around an open courtyard, seven double-sided walls under one timber pavilion, **350** niches in all. Every niche carries 2 rights of interment — two people, usually a husband and wife, on one contract.



Rock of Ages, from the lawn. The pavilion covers the whole courtyard, so the walls are sheltered but the place is open on every side.

A niche is a compartment for cremated remains, closed with a granite front. The urn goes inside. The front is what your family sees and touches when they visit, and the name and dates are engraved into the stone itself rather than carried on a plate.

THE TWO SIDES

Inside and Out

Courtyard faces and outward faces are two different places to be

Wall D stands across the head of the courtyard, on its own.

Half of the faces look into the courtyard and half look out over the lawn. The courtyard faces are the sheltered, enclosed side. You stand between two walls with the benches beside you. The outward faces look across open grass and trees. It is the same building and the same stone; it is a genuinely different place to stand, and families almost always know which one is theirs once they have stood in both.

Tiers run A at the bottom to E at the top, five spaces across each face. Price follows the tier and the face: the higher tiers and the courtyard faces are the most sought after, the lower tiers on the outward faces the least.

Choosing a Niche

The two decisions that set the price

GRANITE FRONT • TWO RIGHTS • THE SHELTERED SIDE

These face into the courtyard, between the two banks, with the memorial benches in front of them. They are the most sought-after faces here and are priced above the outward ones.

COURTYARD FACES, GENERALLY

GRANITE FRONT • TWO RIGHTS • LOOKING OVER THE LAWN

The outward faces look out across mown lawn and trees rather than into the courtyard. The least expensive niches at Rock of Ages are the bottom tier of an outward face.

OUTWARD FACES, GENERALLY

\$7,995–\$13,195

Across the whole columbarium, niches currently for sale run \$7,995–\$15,995, depending on the face and the tier. Your family service director will confirm the exact price of any niche before anything is written down.

What Comes With It

What the niche price covers, and what is charged alongside it



Names are engraved into the granite front itself and filled, rather than carried on a separate plate.

The price of the niche buys the space and its two rights of interment. The engraving, the opening and closing when someone is placed, the recording of the interment, the bronze vase and the Endowment Care Fund contribution are charged alongside it.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

Opening and closing, recording, endowment care and any inscription are charged in addition to the price of the space. They are straightforward, and they differ by location and by what you choose. Call or email me and I will put the exact figures in writing for you, with no obligation.

What Is Available Now

Available now, not a waiting list

303 of the 350 niches at Rock of Ages are for sale today: 157 on the courtyard faces and **146** on the outward faces. This is one of the places at Washington Memorial Park where a family can still choose the wall, the face and the height rather than take what is left.

BEFORE YOU COME OUT

Decide which side you want. Courtyard or outward. Stand in both if you can; it is the decision families feel most strongly about. **Then decide the height.** A niche at eye level and one on the bottom tier are the same size and a very different price. Two rights come with every niche, so a couple is one contract either way.

Ranges here are computed from the price and availability data behind our live niche maps, so they describe what is offered for sale today and move as spaces sell. I confirm the exact niche, its price and today’s availability before anything is signed.
