

Urn Placement Options

Every place cremated remains can rest at Washington Memorial Park, side by side, with what each one costs.

Three ways, two urns

Cremated remains rest here in one of three ways: a niche in a columbarium, burial of the urn in the ground, or scattering. **Every niche at Washington Memorial Park carries the right to place two urns**, so a couple is one contract; the only exception is the Veterans Court of Honor, where a niche holds one.

Garden of Meditation

OUTDOOR · GRANITE FRONT

Curved granite walls in an established garden near the chapel, with benches and mature planting around them.

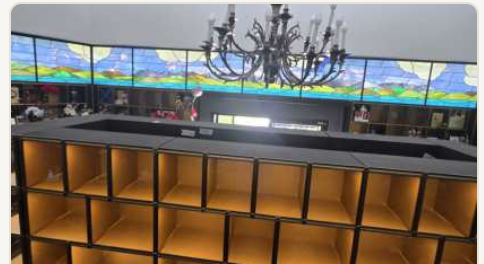
Rock of Ages Columbarium

OUTDOOR · GRANITE FRONT

A natural-stone courtyard built into the hillside. It is sheltered and quiet, and it looks out over the park.

NICHE PRICE RANGE

\$7,995–\$15,995



Mountain View Columbarium

INDOOR · GLASS FRONT

A glass-front island indoors, where the urn and a few keepsakes stay in view. Open and comfortable year round.

Radiance & Serenity

INDOOR · GLASS FRONT

Two indoor glass-front walls. Families set photographs and small keepsakes beside the urn, which makes these the most personal option here.

Eternal Light Columbarium

INDOOR · GLASS FRONT

Warm light, stone floors and a room to sit in. Openings run from a single niche up to a family-sized one.

OUTDOOR · GRANITE FRONT

A granite niche bank on the Terrace Garden Memorial Path, the newest part of the park.

Ground Burial of an Urn



A standard grave space

ANYWHERE IN THE PARK • UP TO THREE URNS

An urn can go into an ordinary grave space in any section, and one space holds up to three. This is what families choose to be beside relatives already here.

Lake Urn Garden

BUILT FOR URN BURIAL • ONE URN PER SPACE

Spaces sized for cremated remains at the front of the park, beside the lake and the fountains. The more affordable of the two.

SPACE

\$5,495

Both carry the same charges beyond the space: endowment care, opening and closing, the recording fee, and a flush marker quoted separately. **Anything buried has to survive being there**, so the urn either goes inside an urn vault or is one rated for burial. I will price the number of placements you have in mind.

Permanent marker?	Yes, engraved faceplate	Yes, flush granite marker	Yes, commemorative plaque
Urn visible?	Glass-front option available	No, buried underground	N/A, remains scattered
Companion option?	Yes, every niche holds two urns	Yes, up to 3 urns in a standard space	Yes, same garden
Weather-protected?	Indoor options available	No, outdoor garden	Outdoor
A place to visit?	Yes, a dedicated location	Yes, a dedicated location	Garden area, less specific
